# Israel, Hamas agree to ceasefire after days of deadly fighting

#### **JERUSALEM**

ISRAEL and the Palestinian militant group Hamas have agreed to a ceasefire, bringing to an end 11 days of bombardment, the heaviest flare-up since the 2014 Gaza War, that has left over 240 people dead and threatened to destabilise the volatile region.

The ceasefire, which followed mounting pressure from the US, Egypt and other international brokers to halt the violence, came into effect on Friday. The Israeli Security Cabinet voted to accept the ceasefire late Thursday as the Israeli south and Gaza remain inflamed.

However, the truce faced an early test when clashes broke out between Palestinian protesters and Israeli police following Friday prayers at the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound, a flashpoint holy site in Jerusalem that is sacred to Jews and

Muslims. It was unclear what sparked the violence. Police fired stun grenades and tear gas, and Palestinians hurled rocks after hundreds took part in a celebratory demonstration in which they waved Palestinian and Hamas flags and cheered the militant group. Protesters also clashed with Israeli troops in parts of the occupied West Bank,

which has seen violent demonstrations in recent days linked to Jerusalem and

Netanyahu did however inform the Israel Defence Forces to prepare for a scenario in which Hamas did not respond

to Egypt's ceasefire offer. Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi thanked US President Joe Biden for his role in the success of the Egyptian

brokered ceasefire between Israel and Hamas. He added that both see the urgency in managing the conflict between the parties through diplomacy.

Biden hailed the ceasefire, saying both Palestinians and Israelis deserve to live safely. "I believe the Palestinians and Israelis equally deserve to live safely and securely and to enjoy equal measures of freedom, prosperity, and democracy. My administration will continue our quiet, relentless diplomacy toward that end. I believe we have a genuine opportunity to make progress and I'm committed to working for it," Biden said on Thursday. "We remain committed to working with the United Nations and other international stakeholders to provide rapid humanitarian assistance and to marshal international support for the people of Gaza and the Gazan reconstruction efforts," he said.

Fighting began in Gaza on May 10 after weeks of rising Israeli-Palestinian tension in East Jerusalem that culminated in clashes at a holy site revered by both Muslims and Jews. Hamas began firing rockets after warning Israel to withdraw from the site, triggering retaliatory airstrikes. Israeli Defence Minister Benny Gantz said the Gaza offensive had yielded "unprecedented military gains". Israel carried out hundreds of air strikes in Gaza, while Hamas has fired more than 4,000 rockets at central and southern Israel

# Indonesia Muslims protest against Israel airstrikes

## **JAKARTA**

MORE than a thousand Muslims rallied outside the US Embassy in Jakarta on Friday to denounce American support for Israel and demand an end to Israeli airstrikes in the Gaza Strip.

The protesters marched from several mosques after Friday prayers to a major street outside the embassy, which was under heavy police guard.

They halted traffic along the way as they chanted 'Allahu Akbar,' or 'God is Great,' and 'Save Palestinians.'

Authorities with loudspeakers warned protesters to maintain social distancing during the demonstration, organised by the Islamic Student Association and several other groups, to prevent the spread of the Covid. More than 3,000 police, many wearing hazmat suits, were deployed to secure the embassy and the nearby presidential palace and UN mission.

Indonesia, the world's most populous Muslim-majority nation, does not have formal diplomatic relations with Israel and there is no Israeli embassy in the country.

It has been a strong supporter of Palestinians, and Presi-

dent Joko Widodo has condemned the Israeli airstrikes. Media reports said similar protests were held in at least

10 provincial capitals and cities across Indonesia.
